Who Bleeds When the Wolves Bite?

Like many of you, I have been on the front lines in dealing with activist hedge funds. The inherent tension of these situations is often exacerbated by the inability of companies to know, in any kind of timely manner, the level or even the existence of, ownership by the fund(s) involved.

In one instance, a hedge fund brought suit against my company, and the Delaware Chancery Court ultimately ruled in our favor. The judge in the case was Leo E. Strine, Jr., who is now Chief Justice of the Delaware Supreme Court. That's why it caught my eye when Ted Allen alerted me to Strine's recent paper, "[Who Bleeds When the Wolves Bite? A Flesh-and-Blood Perspective on Hedge Fund Activism and Our Strange Corporate Governance System.](#)" Among other things, he concludes that hedge funds, "should be required to disclose accurate and timely information about their operations and interests."

Given Delaware's significance in the public company realm, it is comforting to know that Strine shares the view of NIRI members.
